

Security Statement

Our credit union is constantly concerned about our member's critical information and privacy. With this in mind, we have the following security services installed on our Internet server:

- Each server is behind a Firewall.
- A SSL Certificate is installed on our site through the Let's Encrypt Certificate Authority.
- Our website is hosted in a SSAE 16 Certified Data Center
- Our website data center is armed and rock solid with the latest in security software.
- We provide proactive server management. Our servers are heavily monitored for any suspicious activity or potential outage,
- Each server runs proprietary software that constantly monitors the servers for unauthorized use and attempts to "hack" into information.
- Administrators are contacted when forced attacks are committed, and countermeasures can be applied to stop these instances.
- All administrative activity requires user login and authentication. All administrative updates are logged into files that can be reviewed later.
- Traffic between the web server and its visitors is protected by SSL encryption.
- We have what is considered to be the strongest and most secure web server software on the market.
